

RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF BEACHWOOD AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A COMPETITIVE CONTRACTING PROCEDURE FOR THE ANNUAL 4th OF JULY FIREWORKS DISPLAY FOR JULY 4, 2010, 2011 & 2012

WHEREAS, the Borough of Beachwood annually holds a river front fireworks display on the 4th of July; and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to solicit and obtain competitive contracting proposals in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.1; and

WHEREAS, said competitive contracting shall be administered through the Borough Clerk and the Borough Attorney; and

WHEREAS, said individuals shall prepare a request for proposals documentation to include requirements deemed appropriate necessary to allow for full and free competition among various vendors; and

WHEREAS, said proposal information shall include the methodology by which the Borough will evaluate and rank proposals received from various vendors; and

WHEREAS, said process shall be carried out in accordance with the dictates of the aforementioned Statute and N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.5; and

WHEREAS, upon receipt of proposals the Borough Clerk and Attorney shall evaluate said proposals with the Fireworks Committee and prepare a report recommending the award and to include a list of all potential vendors and their ranking based upon the criteria for same; and

WHEREAS, said report shall be made available to the public at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to the awarding of said contract in accordance with statutory authorization.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Beachwood, County of Ocean and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. That the Borough Clerk, the Borough Attorney, and the Fireworks Commissioner

are authorized to establish the competitive contracting proposal for fireworks displays on July 4, 2010, July 4, 1011, and July 4, 2012 in accordance with the preamble hereof.

2. That upon recommendation and subsequent award by the governing body, a notice of that action shall be published in an official newspaper of the Borough. Said notice shall include the date or dates of said contract, the name of the vendor, and a statement that said Resolution and Contract are on file for public inspection in the office of the Borough Clerk.

3. Upon the adoption of the within Resolution the Borough Clerk is authorized to forward a duly authenticated copy of it to the Borough Administrator and the Borough Attorney.
