JCP&L Storm Restoration Work Continues

Free Water and Ice Available to JCP&L Customers Without Power

January 24, 2017 – 6 a.m.

Morristown, N.J. – Jersey Central Power & Light (JCP&L) utility crews, assisted by personnel from other FirstEnergy utilities and local contractors, continue working to restore service to about 987 customers who remain without power after strong winds and heavy rain moved through the region late Sunday night and early Monday morning.

Beginning at 6:00 a.m., JCP&L customers who remain without power can pick up water and ice free of charge at the following locations:

JCP&L currently anticipates that the remaining customers without power will be restored by late this evening. Approximately 54,880 JCP&L customers were originally affected by the storm, with the hardest hit areas in Monmouth, Ocean and Burlington counties.

Customers who are without power are encouraged to call 1-888-LIGHTSS (1-888-544-4877) to report their outage or click the “Report Outage” link on www.firstenergycorp.com. Customers should immediately report downed wires to 1-888-LIGHTSS (1-888-544-4877) or their local police or fire department. Customers should never go near a downed power line, even if they think it is no longer carrying electricity. Extra caution should be exercised in areas where downed wires may be tangled in downed tree branches or other debris.
