REMEMBRANCE PRAYER


While we pray for the safe return of our serving men and women, we must remember that servicemen and women from New Jersey have been killed in service for our country, Iraq, Afghanistan and around the world

FIRST READING FOR BOND ORDINANCE 2022-01 READ BY TITLE ONLY Read by Municipal Clerk

ORDINANCE 2022-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BEACHWOOD, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING FOR IMPROVEMENTS AND REPAIRS TO THE BEACHWOOD MARINA AND APPROPRIATING \$250,000 THEREI'OR AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF \$237,500 IN BONDS OR NOTES OF THE BOROUGH OF BEACHWOOD TO FINANCE THE SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF BEACHWOOD, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The improvement or purpose described in Section 3 of this bond ordinance is hereby authorized to be undertaken by the Borough of Beachwood, in the County of Ocean, New Jersey (the "Borough") as ger eral improvements. For Section 5. The capital budget or temporary capital budget (as applicable) of the Borough i: he eby amended to conform with the provisions of this bond ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. In the event of any such inconsistency and amendment, the resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget or amended temporary capital budget (as applicable) and capital program as a proved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 6. The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated:

- (a) The improvements or purposes described in Section 3 of this bond ordinance are not a current expense and are improvements or purposes that the Borough may lawfully undertake as general capital improvements, and no part of the costs thereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefited thereby.
- (b) The period of usefulness of the improvements or purposes, within the limitations of the Local Bond Law, according to the reasonable life thereof computed from the date of the bonds authorized by this ordinance, is 20 years.
- and filed in the office of the Clerk, and a complete executed duplicate thereof has been filed in the office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey. Such statement shows that the gross debt of the Borough as defined in the Local Bond Law is increased by the authorization of the bonds and notes provided in this bond ordinance by \$237,500, and the obligations authorized herein will be within all debt limitations prescribed by that Law.
- (d) An aggregate amount not exceeding \$50,000 for items of expense listed in and permitted under N.J.S.A. 40A:2-20 is included in the estimated cost indicated herein for the improvements or purposes.
- The Borough reasonably expects to commence the acquisition and, or construction of the improvements or purposes described in Section 3 hereof, and to advance all or a portion of the costs in respect thereof, prior to the issuance of bonds or notes hereunder. To the extent such costs are advanced, the Borough further reasonably expects to reimburse such expenditures from the proceeds of the bonds or notes authorized by this bond ordinance, in an aggregate amount not to exceed the amount of bonds or notes authorized in Section 2 hereof.

Section 7. Any grant moneys received for the purposes described in Section 3 hereof shall be applied either to direct payment of the cost of the improvements or to payment of the obligations issued pursuant to this bond ordinance. The amount of obligations authorized hereunder shall be reduced to the extent that such funds are so used.

Section 8. The full faith and credit of the Borough is hereby pledged to the purctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this bond ordinance. The obligations in all be direct, unlimited obligations of the Borough, and the Borough shall be obligated to levy ad valorem taxes upon all the tax able real property within the Borough for the payment of the obligations and the interest thereon without limitation of rate or amount.

Section 9. The Borough hereby covenants to take any action necessary or refrain from taking such action in order to preserve the tax-exempt status of the bonds and notes authorized hereunder as is or may be required under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and the regulations promulgated thereunder (the Code"), including compliance with the Code with regard to the use, expenditure, investment, timely reporting and retate of investment earnings as may be required thereunder.

Section 10. To the extent that any previous ordinance or resolution is inconsister therewith or contradictory hereto, said ordinance or resolution is hereby repealed or amended to the extent necessary to make it consistent herewith.

Section 11. This bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first public Itio I thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
