ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BEACHWOOD, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 15, SECTION 15-1.9 ENTITLED "RATES AND CHARGES" TO INCREASE THE WATER CONNECTION OR HOOK-UP FEES AND TO ESTABLISH FEES FOR WATER METER TESTS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Beachwood, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 15-1.6 entitled "Terms of Payment" is hereby supplemented by the inclusion of the following:

"Sub-section e. In the event that a water customer requests a water meter reading the charge shall be \$25.00. In the event of a subsequent request the fee will be \$25.00 per reading."

SECTION 2. Section 15-1.9e of the Code of the Borough of Beachwood is hereby deleted and in its place and stead the following shall be inserted:

"e. Water connection fees or hookup fees as discussed in Subsection 15-1.2 are hereby established as follows:

1"	\$3,000.00
1 1/2"	\$3,000.00
2"	\$4,000.00
4"	\$5,000.00

SECTION 3. This Ordinance repeals any inconsistent ordinance or ordinances or part or parts thereof.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.
