Permit Requirements for Open Flame producing devices

All open flame producing devices used for cooking, either FOOD CARTS or FOOD TRUCKS shall obtain A type I Permit from the Local Enforcing Agency prior to commencing operation in accordance with The New Jersey Fire Code N.J.A.C. 5:70-2.7

A Type I permit application can be obtained from the Beachwood Fire Official by e-mailing the request to: beachwoodfireprevention@comcast.net in advance of the event so proper processing can be conducted.

The Fee for A Type I permit is \$54.00 and is non-refundable. Only cash or checks made out to Beachwood Fire Prevention will be accepted.

Requirements for Food Carts, Open Flame Grills, or other Portable flame producing devices:

#1- Any Food Cart Deep Frying operation using vegetable oil **SHALL** require (1) -1.5 Gallon minimum capacity **Wet Chemical Fire extinguisher** in compliance with Annual Inspection and properly secured in a location readily accessible near the cooking operation. Ref: N.J.A.C. 5:70-3, 904.12.5.2

#2- All other open flame Operations **NOT** using deep fryers **SHALL** require (1) -Dry Chemical Fire Extinguisher with a minimum rating of 2-A, 10 B:C properly secured and readily accessible near the open flame operation Ref: N.J.A.C. 5:70-906.1

#3- All Propane cylinders used for the cooking operation **SHALL** be properly secured at all times Ref: N.J.A.C. 5:70-3, 5303.3.5.3 **Propane cylinders that are properly "nested" in a milk crate style securing device that is out of the public access areas will be permitted.**
